International Freshman Student

A student who has never enrolled in any college following graduation from high/secondary school or completion of the U.S. general education diploma (GED). A student who earned college credit during high school/secondary school is considered a first-time freshman.

1. Complete the International Application for Undergraduate Admission.
2. Return the signed application to University of Missouri, Office of International Admissions, 230 Jesse Hall, Columbia MO 65211.
3. All applications must include a US\$60.00 non-refundable fee drawn in U.S. funds.
4. Request official, sealed (still in envelope) high school/secondary school transcripts or mark sheets, and an official English language translation of documents not issued in English, be sent directly to the Admissions Office directly from the issuing institution. Academic records should include all necessary exam scores, certificates or diplomas to evidence completion of high school/secondary school.
5. Submit official scores from TOEFL, IELTS, SAT, or ACT exams. Show proof of English proficiency by providing one of the following:
 - a. TOEFL score: 500+(paper); or 61+(internet)
 - b. IELTS score: 6.5+ overall band scoreSome schools and colleges require higher English language proficiency scores.
6. If you have earned university-level credit while in high school/secondary school, request official transcripts from the college(s) or university(ies) be mailed directly to the Office of International Admissions.
7. To issue immigration documents (I-20 or DS-2019) upon admission to the University of Missouri, international applicants must submit an official bank document evidencing ability to pay one year's cost of attendance. This figure is calculated from costs associated with tuition, non-resident fees, room & board, estimates for textbooks, personal expenses, travel and mandatory health insurance. Scanned copies of necessary documents can be submitted via email to inter@missouri.edu.

International Transfer Student

A student who has enrolled in a college or university since high school/secondary school but has never attended the University of Missouri.

1. Complete the International Application for Undergraduate Admission.
2. Return the signed application to University of Missouri, Office of International Admissions, 230 Jesse Hall, Columbia MO 65211.
3. All applications must include a US\$60.00 non-refundable fee drawn in U.S. funds.
4. Request official, sealed (still in envelope) high school/secondary school transcripts or mark sheets, and an official English language translation if not issued in English, be sent directly to the Office of International Admissions directly from the issuing institution. Academic records should include all necessary exam scores, certificates or diplomas to evidence completion of high school/secondary school. A transfer student who has earned over 24 transferable semester hours may not be required to submit a high school/secondary school transcript.
5. Request official, sealed (still in envelope) college or university transcripts, including an official English language translation of documents not issued in English, be sent directly to the Office of International Admissions directly from the issuing institution.
6. Show proof of English proficiency by providing one of the following:
 - a. TOEFL score: 500+(paper); or 61+(internet)
 - b. IELTS score: 6.5+ overall band scoreSome schools and colleges require higher English language proficiency scores.
7. To issue immigration documents (I-20 or DS-2019) upon admission to the University of Missouri, international applicants must submit an official bank document evidencing ability to pay one year's cost of attendance. This figure is calculated from costs associated with tuition, non-resident fees, room & board, estimates for textbooks, personal expenses, travel and mandatory health insurance. Scanned copies of necessary documents can be submitted via email to inter@missouri.edu.
8. Applicants transferring from a college or university within the U.S., who currently hold F-1 or J-1 status are also required to complete a Transfer Authorization form, available online at <http://international.missouri.edu/come-to-mu/students/transfer-instructions/index.php>

Exchange Applicants

A student who is seeking admission to the University of Missouri as part of an approved exchange or study abroad program through a partner university or organization.

1. Complete the International Application for Undergraduate Admission.
2. Unless directed otherwise from the sending partner university or organization, Return the signed application to University of Missouri, Office of International Admissions, 230 Jesse Hall, Columbia MO 65211.
3. Most applications must include a US\$60.00 non-refundable fee drawn in U.S. funds. However, applicants from approved exchange partner universities may be exempt from the application fee.
4. Request official, sealed (still in envelope) college or university transcripts be sent directly to the Admissions Office directly from the issuing institution.
5. Show proof of English proficiency by providing one of the following:
 - a. TOEFL score: 500+(paper); or 61+(internet)
 - b. IELTS score: 6.5+ overall band scoreSome schools and colleges require higher English language proficiency scores.
6. To issue a DS-2019 form upon admission to the University of Missouri, international applicants must submit an official bank document evidencing ability to pay one year's cost of attendance. This figure is calculated from costs associated with room & board, estimates for textbooks, personal expenses, transportation, and mandatory health insurance. Exchange applicants may not be required to evidence costs associated with tuition and non-resident fees. Scanned copies of necessary documents can be submitted via email to inter@missouri.edu.

- Failure to submit ALL official transcripts and test scores may result in denial of the application or dismissal from the University of Missouri.
- Students utilizing agents for assistance with the application and admission process to the University of Missouri are held responsible for any information or documents provided to the agent, but not forwarded to the student.

**Financial Documentation Requirements
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Application for Admission**



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Educational institutions in the United States are required by the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) to have documentary proof of at least one year of adequate financial support before issuing immigration documents to admitted international students. Applicants who do not provide acceptable financial documentation will not be issued necessary immigration documents required to obtain the appropriate visa for study within the United States. Applicants who enter the United States on a tourist on a tourist or business visa will not be permitted to enroll in classes at the University of Missouri.

Financial Sponsors

Applicants who are providing financial documents from a sponsor are required to submit a signed affidavit of support, completed by their financial sponsor. The applicant must submit a completed affidavit form with supporting documentation. The affidavit must be less than one year old upon intended date of enrollment or date of I-20 or DS-2019 update. All financial documentation must be of value equal to or greater than the estimated annual cost of attendance at the University of Missouri.
